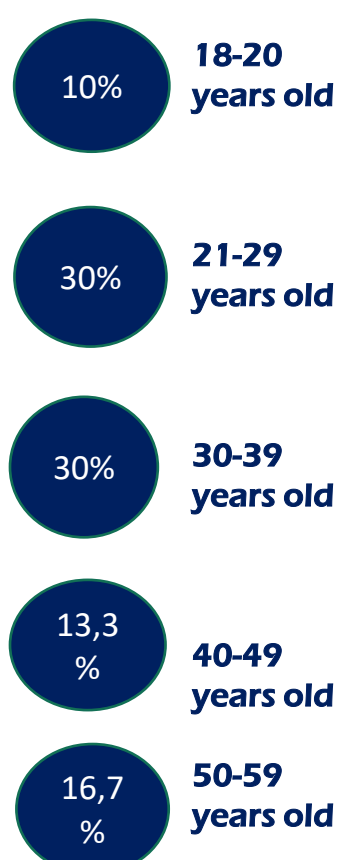

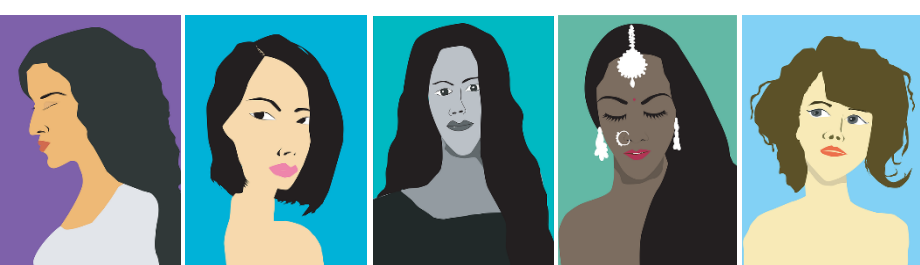

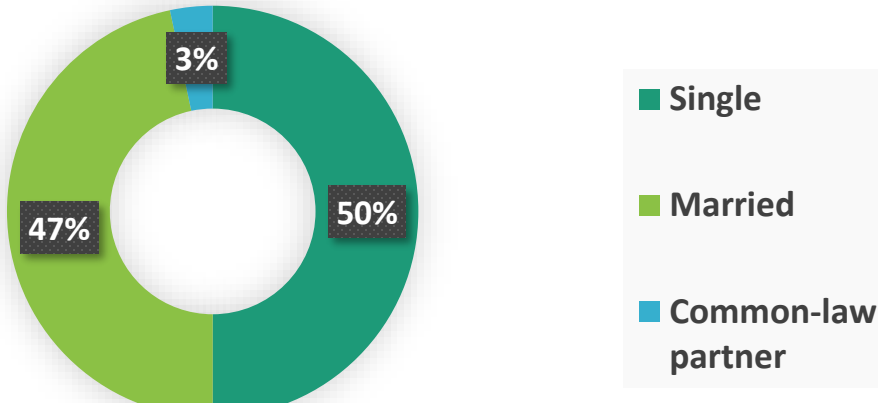


30 % has Arabic language as mother tongue

- 7% Undergraduate (without baccalaureate)

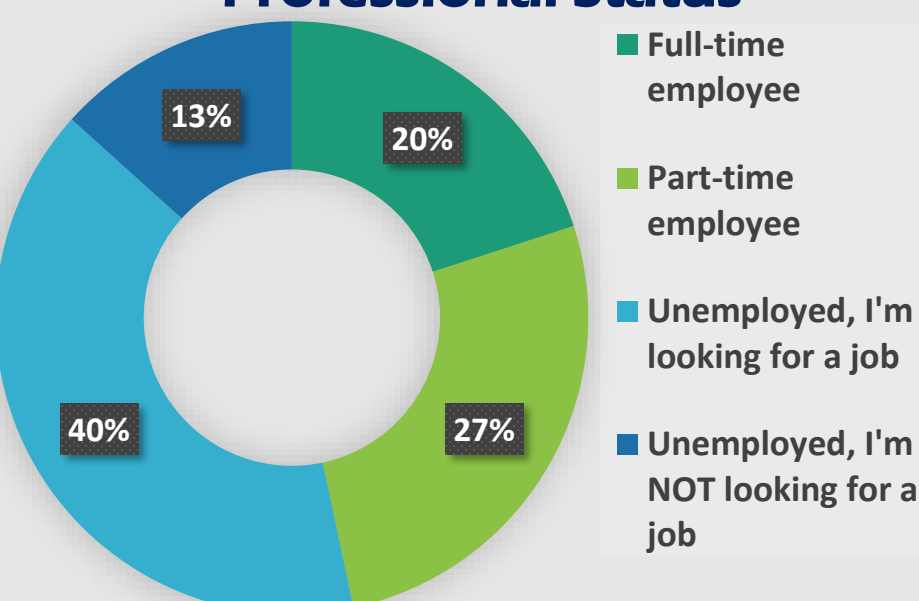

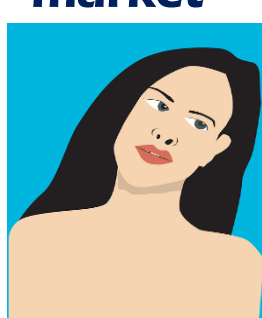

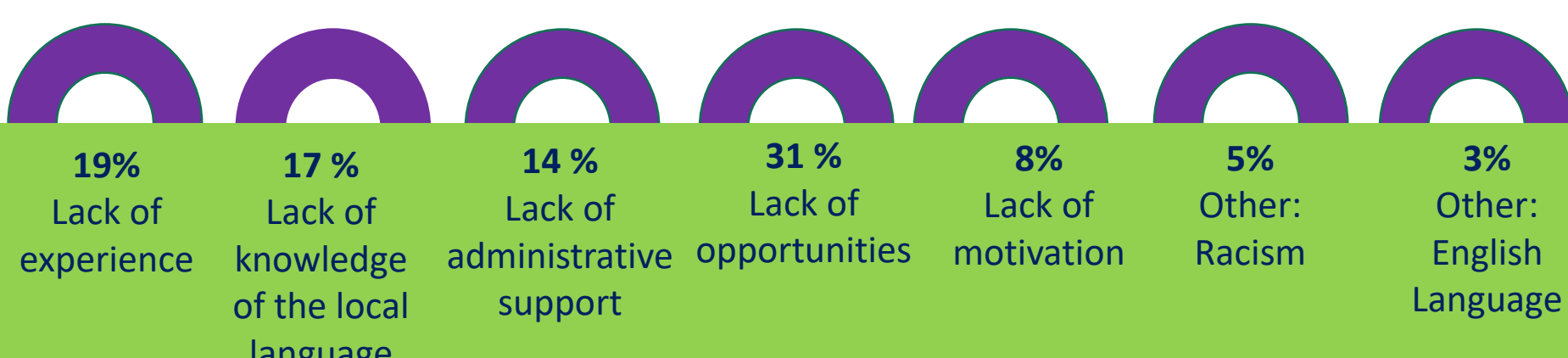


**The most relevant digital skills for the job market**
